It is important to remember that the "script" is simply a tool to guide you through a phone call. The intention is to help you organize your thinking and make sure that you say things correctly without misinterpretation, and the antique/furniture dealers correctly understand what you are asking them. Here is a modified version of your script that you can use when you call them. I would suggest that you make a calendar event for yourself on Google, schedule it for Tuesday afternoon at 3 or 4pm, and call them and go through this script:

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*Hi, my name is Luke Killeffer, and I am a Life Scout with BSA Troop 41 in Abington. My Eagle Scout project is to renovate two rooms in the American Legion building on Washington Street so that the space there becomes usable again, and the Legion can convert one of the rooms into an office and the other into storage space.*

*Right now there are a number of old furniture items, including chairs, antique school desks, a card table, restaurant-style benches, a pool table, vinyl records, filing cabinets, some vintage electronics (including a Tandy computer complete with mouse, keyboard, monitor, etc.) and all sorts of other items. I was wondering if you might be interested in coming out to take a look at some of the things that we have that the Legion has authorized me to sell as part of the project. Myself or my Scoutmaster can be available most weekend nights to guide you through what we have. Can we schedule a date and time that would be convenient for you to visit and bid on the items we have for sale?*

Luke, it is now the end of May. If you are going to be able to get antique and furniture shops to buy the stuff that is in the American Legion Abington attic, YOU NEED TO CALL THEM, FOLLOW YOUR SCRIPT, and SET A DATE AND TIME FOR THEM to show up and bid on items. We had originally planned for the attic to be 100% empty by now (except for dismantling the HVAC of the smoke system), but you are still very far off from that goal. If you don't secure dates and times for the antique/furniture dealers to come to the Legion in the next week, you might as well plan to trash everything up there, and if you do that, you will definitely need to do some fundraising to cover the costs of the materials we need.

As soon as you get home, STOP, print out the script that I gave you, and make some phone calls. Have mom nearby and close enough so that she can hear, and then make the calls. Ask what dates and times they could come, and tell them you will call them back after your check with me, Scoutmaster Schultz, and Ken Coburn to make sure that at least one of us can be there with you to host the dealers.
