Hi Ken & Chris,

I wanted to follow-up on the work we did over the weekend (Luke is away at a camp with church this week and won't be back until Sunday, 7/21). We broke down a large portion of the items in the attic that needed to be cut down for disposal, including the red benches, lots and lots of wood items, brought many things to the curb for giveaway, and began disassembly of the ductwork (we still have more to do to disassemble the ductwork but I didn't have my socket set and we ran out of time). Originally we had thought we would scrap the sheet metal from the ductwork, but upon looking at the state of the interior of that ductwork, I don't think it would be worth it to transport/handle those (even with gloves, eye protection, and a respirator, handling the ductwork is *nasty* business and I would not recommend to anyone to touch those but rather we will bring them straight into the dumpster once space is available. I am presuming that we want to dispose of that pool table as well?

There were a few things that we needed some clarification on what to do with (golf clubs, treasure chest, etc.), so we can schedule some time to review those.

For now the attic on the right hand side should be considered an open work site, and I would recommend people stay out of that area unless they are assisting with the trash removal. The dumpster was full, so we have several large contractor clean-up bags with wood and misc. trash to be hauled away to the dumpster over the next couple of weeks. Next week
