Hi Ken -

I wanted to help clarify what items Luke is recommending for the Legion. Tonight we went over and made up a proposed list of materials we would need for the project, and we came up with 4 potential door selections. I also have a plan for what to do to repair the parts of the attic floor where we will be removing the sheet metal ductwork (basically a cross-shaped joist support beams held in place by joist hangers, and a plywood top). We did have a few questions for you on the door beyond selecting the door itself:

- Do you want the circle room door to be locked from the outside with a key?
- Do you want a deadbolt?
- Can the key for the door handle be the same for the deadbolt?

Hello Mr. Coburn,

I wanted to share a progress update with you on my Eagle project - we accomplished a lot this weekend! For starters, I ran a fundraising campaign last week, and here's a rundown:

- purchased 480 Hilliard's chocolate bars on Tuesday, and began door-to-door selling all over Braintree from Wednesday-Friday, sold 137 bars
- requested and obtained permission from Store Manager Bill Mullen at the Abington Lowes to sell candy on Saturday
- sold all the remaining candy bars at Lowes on Saturday, along with lemonade
- after all expenses, and including the initial \$100 donation from an American Legion member to my project, \$45 in scrap metal reimbursements, and the candy sales and donations, I have raised over \$800 for my project (should more than cover all necessary building materials)

I just shared some pictures with you via Google Drive of the work progress that my dad, brothers, and grandpa did to the Legion attic this weekend while I was fundraising - they did a bunch! I believe we're very close to being done with the demolition and disposal of all the trash **but I wanted to ask to meet with you on Tuesday evening during the Troop meeting to review the following:**

- go over the remaining items in the attic: what needs to be disposed of, what could be left, etc. (pool table? large metal items? chest?)
- briefly review our plans for repairing the floor where the smoke-eater ductwork used to be coming up through the floor and also exhausting out the window
- get final approval from you on our door selection (please see the email my dad sent on July 9th for the listing of doors we are recommending we select from)

Also, an important reminder - the ductwork that was coming up through the floorboards has been nearly completely removed (just a bit more on one of the ducts needs to be removed), but they are very dangerous until we are able to repair the floor (people could potentially fall right through to the meeting room below). Temporarily we positioned the large ductwork motor over one of the holes to block anyone from potentially slipping through, but we might want to further cordon off those holes until we can perform the necessary repairs (planning to do that next Saturday).

Looking forward to meeting with you on Tuesday evening!
